GREENVISION AMBIENTE AND THE MARSEGLIA GROUP SIGN A LETTER OF INTENT FOR THE REALISATION OF A 13 MW PHOTOVOLTAIC SYSTEM. THE GREENVISION GROUP CONTINUES ITS DEVELOPMENT IN THE RENEWABLE ENERGY SECTOR, IN PARTICULAR WASTE TO ENERGY AND PHOTOVOLTAIC, AND RULES OUT MERGERS WITH OTHER OPERATORS IN THE SECTOR

San Polo D'Enza (RE), 10 November 2009 – Greenvision ambiente and the Marseglia Group have, through their respective subsidiaries, Greenvision ambiente Photo-Solar and KM Energy, signed a letter of intent for the construction of a 13 MW photovoltaic park in Calabria.

The plant has been designed and developed by the Greenvision ambiente subsidiary for an area of 34 hectares in the province of Cosenza and, according to the company's plans, will go online before the end of 2010, with sufficient energy to meet the needs of about 6,500 families, annually saving the equivalent of 3,100 tons of oil and avoiding the emission of 8,000 tons of CO₂.

The Marseglia Group, based in Monopoli, is one of Italy's leading producers of energy from renewable sources, with installed power output exceeding 150 MW, of which about 20 MW from photovoltaic parks.

Following its recent divestitures, the Greenvision ambiente Group has redefined its areas of activity, the outlines of growth for which are marked not only by the photovoltaic sector, but also by waste to energy, and specifically biogas and the production of fuel from waste, in which it can boast leadership in the Italian market through its subsidiary, Ladurner of Bolzano.

Greenvision ambiente will continue its development principally via its organic activities, exploiting the growth in the reference markets foreseen for the next few years, and rules out further extraordinary operations as regards company structure and/or mergers with other companies operating in the sector.
